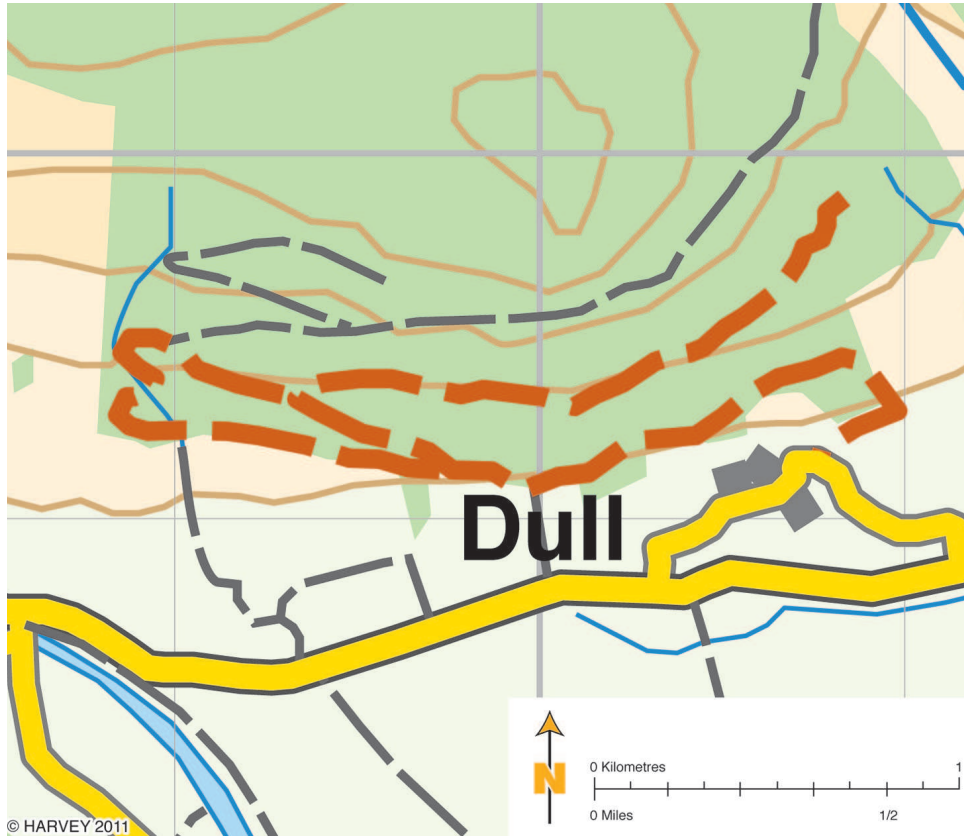

ROUTE DESCRIPTION

Turn right out the Highland Safaris entrance and follow the main road 200 metres up to the village of Dull. Turn right in the centre of Dull onto the public right of way. After a small metal gate take the next left turn through another 2 metal gates and into the Forest. After 300 metres turn right up the gravel forest track. From there, take your choice of routes:

Take first left to cycle along the easy flat route to the track end and picnic bench.

As a 2nd option, go right at the first road end onto the grassy mid road for a lovely easy cycle up to the edge of a block of Sitka spruce trees.

As a 3rd option, continue on up the forestry road to the first hairpin bend. Go left through past an old wooden gate and follow the single track through the mature woodland down to the picnic bench

DO THE RIDE THING

We love riding this route and to keep our good relationship with local landowners and other path users we ask you to follow the advice below:

- Let other path users know you are coming as early as possible.
- Please watch your speed especially on blind corners and dips.
- Please take extra care near wildlife and leave the environment as you find it.
- Help land managers and others to work safely and effectively. See 'Route Specifics'.

- The route description and quality of path may change over time so please remain flexible with your plans and be ready to use alternative routes.
- Check the weather forecast and ensure you have all the equipment you need for your route.
- If you are in any doubt please pop into one of our cycle centres for advice!
