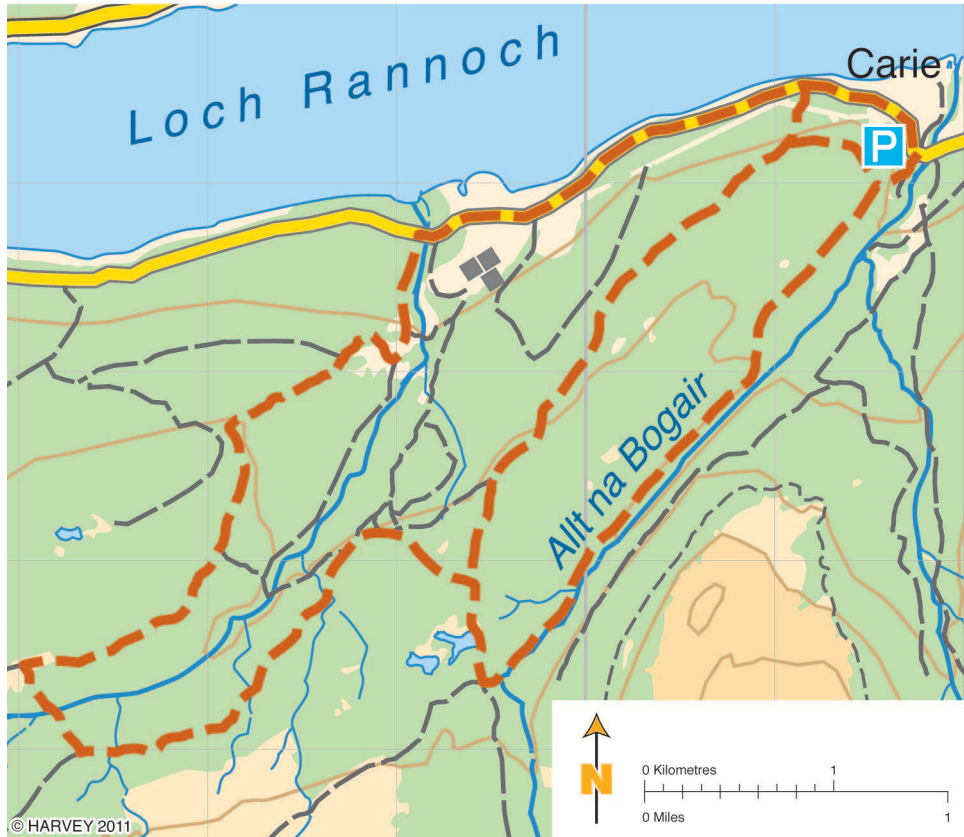

ROUTE DESCRIPTION

The Black Wood of Rannoch is a precious remnant of Scotland's native forests. This clearly waymarked route follows the steep sides of the Allt na Bogair burn, opening out to great views. This, and two other easy shorter paths (Carie and Kilvrecht paths), begin from the Carie Car Park, three miles west of Kinloch Rannoch.

An alternative longer route takes you across the Dall Burn then back down to the loch by Dall House, returning to the car park along the quiet lochside road.

DO THE RIDE THING

- The route description and quality of path may change over time so please remain flexible with your plans and be ready to use alternative routes.
- Check the weather forecast and ensure you have all the equipment you need for your route.
- If you are in any doubt please pop into one of our cycle centres for advice!
